Protection from Retaliation

If you believe you have been retaliated against for blowing the whistle on improper activity, you may file a complaint with the Locally Designated Official. Additionally, Laboratory employees and subcontractor employees* are protected from retaliation under 10 CFR 708 (contact DOE Hearings and Appeals) and 48 CFR 3.908 (contact DOE Office of Inspector General).
